



Acuity-vct New Installations

Museum of Fine Arts – Boston, MA

Acuity-vct has just completed Phase 1 in December at the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston. This included the replacing 64 analog cameras with IP cameras, integrating 56 analog cameras into the Video Capture System. 25 new high resolution fixed and PTZ cameras we also installed in the parking garage.

Frist Center for the Visual Arts – Nashville, TN

Phase 1 was completed in October at the Frist Center for the Visual Arts in Nashville. The Main Level Galleries were installed with new cameras and the Acuity-vct VCS system to protect the "The Birth of Impressionism" (Masterpieces from the Musée D'Orsay). Phase 2 will start in January 2011 to protect the William Eggleston "Anointing the Overlooked" exhibit in the Upper Level galleries.

Georgia Museum of Art – Athens, GA

Cornell University Library – Ithica, NY

The Phase 1 of VCS system was installed September at the Cornell University Library. Phase 2 will begin this summer with the Rare Books Library application.

The Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art, Winter Park, FL
